- Project Duration: June 2006 – June 2007
- Management Arrangement: UNDP DEX modality
- Total project budget: USD 75,000

Project objectives



- Support and facilitate the implementation of FOSS as a cost-effective e-governance solutions at local level
- Improve local government's efficiency, effectiveness and responsiveness towards the citizens
- Strengthen democracy, improve governance and facilitate more active citizen participation in the development processes

Project benefits



- Savings in the ICT budgets, reduced costs and less dependency on imported technology and skills
- Stimulating the local software industry with affordable software
- Ability to customize software to local languages and cultures
- Human resource development in the ICT area
- Enabling access to government data without barriers

Main Project Phases:



- **Assessment** of the municipal potentials and **development** of FOSS applications in accordance to the municipal priorities
- **Capacity building**, training and competency development for the municipal employees with the new environment
- **Implementation** of FOSS based e-governance solutions in pilot municipalities
- **Increasing awareness** and knowledge about FOSS benefits at national and local level

Project activities:

Assessment and development



- Assessment of the potentials of the ICT infrastructure and human capacity in municipalities (pre-selection of 10 municipalities)
- Selection of pilot municipalities
- Needs assessment, selection of FOSS tools to be implemented, adaptation to local needs and procurement of additional equipment
- Development of FOSS based services and applications at local level

Project activities: Capacity building



- Training needs analyses
- Training of the ICTC/Foundation staff
- Redesigning and adjusting training curriculums
- Training of municipal administration (Linux basics and Open Office)

Project activities: Implementation



- Deployment of redesigned and improved Municipal Web-sites with e-democracy content (FOSS e- forums, on-line discussions, opinion polling system)
- Deployment of new FOSS e-governance solutions at local level

Project activities: Awareness



- Increase awareness and promotion of FOSS potential through organizing national and regional conferences
- Promotion of the FOSS solutions implemented in pilot municipalities

FOSS Applications to be developed



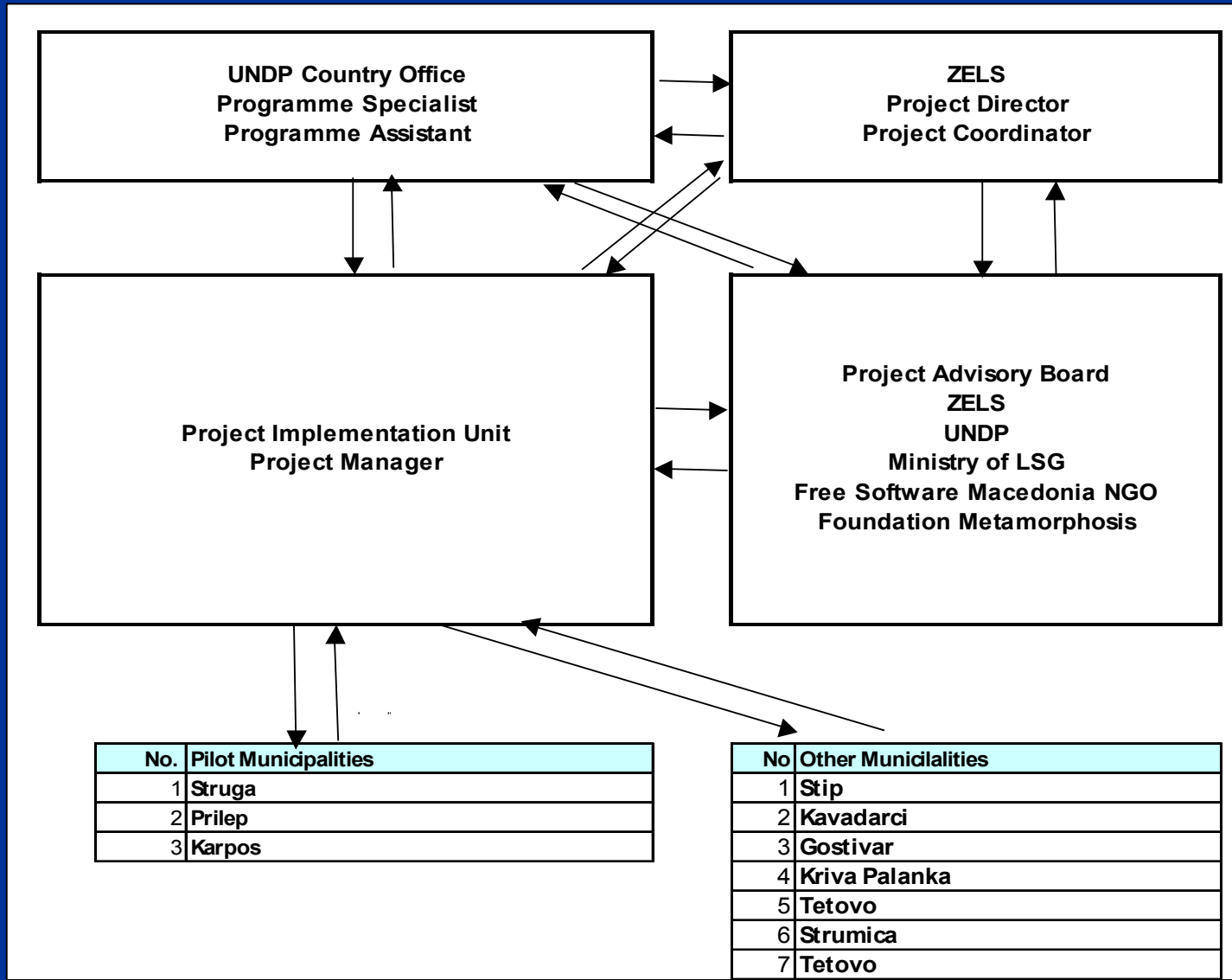
- Struga: Municipal/Citizens e-Services Portal; Redesign of the municipal Web site and upgrade with e-democracy content
- Karposh: Inter-municipal cooperation (e-Municipal Official Gazzete; Best practices), e-Municipal Council
- Prilep: Municipal/Citizens e-Services Portal; Redesign of the municipal Web site and upgrade with e-democracy content; Document (File) Management System and Workflow management;
